While the work of child hygiene has largely to do with schools, its supervision should begin at or before birth, and must continue beyond the average school age. The present investigation has recognized that many incidental improvements may be made without new legislation. Some of these that were recommended in detail, have in certain cases already been adopted. Recommendations. 1. The health functions of Illinois should be grouped into one department under the title of State department of health. The head of this department should be the State commissioner of health. He should be appointed by the governor, entirely on account of his experience and ability, and without limitations as to residence, school of medicine, or politics. He should receive an adequate salary, and should not engage in any other business for profit. His continuance in office should depend entirely on efficiency. 2. A board of health should be appointed by the governor from among those residents of the State most experienced and interested in public health...
